Thank you for your interest in renewing the license for the product "Oil Spill Eater II."



While you did use outdated forms and old contact information for submitting these materials, we will nevertheless process your request for renewing your product. In the future, please contact Ellen Faurot-Daniels of my staff when submitting your license renewal forms. Her contact information has been given to you previously, but is also given again at the bottom of this letter. Ms. Faurot-Daniels requests that you also provide an email address to facilitate future communications.

Enclosed is your license for the oil spill clean-up agent "Oil Spill Eater II." Unless revoked for good cause, this license is valid until July 1, 2021. Be advised that if the U.S. EPA substantively changes their guidance for the NCP Product Schedule listing of bioremediants, you may be requested by the Office of Spill Prevention and Response (OSPR) to re-submit your license application in advance of the 2021 renewal date.

Please be aware that licensing of a product as an oil spill clean-up agent by OSPR in no way constitutes an endorsement by the State of California nor necessitates that the product will be used at the time of a spill. The appropriateness of product use will be assessed on a case-by-case basis at the time oil is released into the waters of the state and will be contingent upon approval by the Administrator of OSPR and the Federal Regional Response Team, Region IX.
